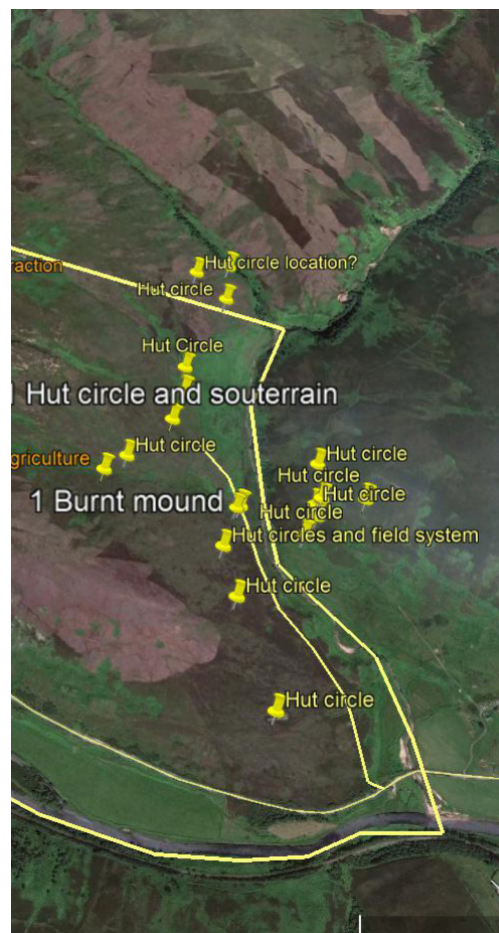
## Saturday 4 May 2019 (cont.)
